- R400.1945(1)(e) Emergency; plan; drill.**



III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

This renewal inspection involved a review of all applicable child care home administrative rules and statutes. Verification of compliance included direct observations of the physical environment and the program, discussions with staff,

and a review of the home's records, including staff records and children's records. Staff records include background checks, medical clearance information, and training information. Children's records include child information cards and child in care statements/receipts.

During the inspection, the child care home was found to be in compliance with all applicable rules and statutes except for the following violations:	
R 400.1919	Communicable disease; immunization; mental and physical health; physician attestation; tuberculosis.

I observed during the onsite inspection and review of the records that household member 2 did not have required consent and disclosure forms on file.



I observed during the onsite inspection that the smoke detector did not work in the basement.	
R 400.1945	Emergency; plan; drill.
	(1) An applicant or licensee shall have a written emergency response plan for the care of children that must be posted in a conspicuous location within the child care home. The plan must address the following types of emergencies: (c) Serious accident or injury.
I observed during the onsite inspection that the licensee did not have a written emergency response plan for serious accident or injury.	
R 400.1945	Emergency; plan; drill.
	1) An applicant or licensee shall have a written emergency response plan for the care of children that must be posted in a conspicuous location within the child care home. The plan must address the following types of emergencies: (e) Crisis management including, but not limited to, all of the following: (i) Intruders. (ii) Active shooters. (iii) Bomb threats. (iv) Other man- or woman-caused events.
I observed during the onsite inspection and review of the records that the licensee did not have a crisis management response plan on file at the time of inspection.	

A corrective action plan was requested and approved on 07/21/2022. It is expected that the corrective action plan be implemented within the specified time frames as outlined in the approved plan. A follow-up evaluation may be made to verify compliance. Should the corrections not be implemented in the specified time, it may be necessary to reevaluate the status of your license.

recommend issuance of a registered license to this child care family home (capacity 1-6).
