III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

A. Description of Facility

The facility is a bungalow style home located on a residential street in Warren. The home has city water and sewage. The home does not have a basement.

Rooms and levels approved for child care use:

On the first floor there are three rooms that are approved for child care use, front room, family room (napping) and 1st floor rear bedroom (napping/diapering).

Areas not approved:

The second floor will not be used.

Ages of children served:

The child care group home will serve children birth to 9 years of age.

Equipment:

The licensee has an adequate amount of developmentally appropriate play equipment and furniture for the requested capacity of 6 children. This includes activities, games, and toys. The child care also has appropriate sleeping equipment; for children birth to 24 months, they will use the 1 pack-n-play and 1 crib. Children 24 months and older will use cots for resting or sleeping.

Proposed days and hours of operation:

The child care family home operates from 6:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., five days a week from Monday through Friday.

Previous or concurrent licenses, including children's foster care:

No previous child care license. Ms. Ross has not been previously licensed for foster care license.

Exiting information (including second floor and basement):

The home has two remote exits: the front and rear door.

Outdoor play area description:

The approved outdoor is a fenced-in backyard. The yard has a large grassy area. Ms. Ross is aware that any equipment, i.e., swing set or play equipment 30 inches or above requires the appropriate cushioning material before child care children can use them. Direct supervision will be provided at all times.
