### III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

#### A. Description of Facility

The facility is a ranch style house located on a residential street in St. Clair Shores. The facility is set back from the street creating a very large front yard. The facility's foundation is a slab with no basement.

Ms. Dunn has requested a maximum capacity of 5 children in care at any one time.

A Radon test was completed on the home on April 4, 2022. The result was 0.3pCi/L, which, is under the allowed maximum of 4pCi/L.

#### **Rooms and levels approved for child care use:**

The following has been approved for child care use:

Main floor: Family room  
Dining area

#### **Areas not approved:**

The bedrooms and loft area have not been approved for child care use.

#### **Ages of children served:**

The program accepts children ages 6 months-old to 2 ½ years-old.

#### **Equipment:**

During a tour of the facility, I observed that Ms. Dunn has the required amount of equipment for the different ages and developmental stages of the age groups and capacity she is requesting.

The equipment includes, but not limited to, child sized furniture, sleeping equipment-play yards and mats, and toys for fine and gross motor development. There are activities for quiet play, sensory development, and creative play.

Educational development activities are also available for early learning activities in reading, science, and math.

Ms. Dunn has a current Child Development Associate credential (CDA) in infant/Toddler development.

#### **Proposed days and hours of operation:**

The facility will operate Monday through Friday 8:30AM to 3:30PM.

#### **Previous or concurrent licenses, including children's foster care:**

Ms. Dunn has no previous licenses in home child care or children's foster care.

**Exiting information (including second floor and basement):**

There are two remote exits on the main floor. The front door and the rear door at the opposite side of the home.

**Outdoor play area description:**

The approved outdoor play area is the front yard. The home sits back from the street creating a large front yard. It is fenced on two sides. Ms. Dunn will have an extended gate creating a safe area that the children in care will play in during child care hours. There are no water hazards present or play structures on the premises at the time of inspection.
