

Staff records include background checks, medical clearance information, and training information. Children's records include child information cards and child in care statements/receipts.

The facility is in compliance with all applicable rules and statutes.

During the inspection, I observed children in resting in safe sleep settings and receiving individualized care. High quality nutrition is provided at this home and the provider has a medical background.

IV. RECOMMENDATION

I recommend issuance of a regular license to this child care family home (capacity 1-6).
