Approved child use space: The main level of the home is approved for child care use including the living room, family room, playroom, kitchen, dining room, and laundry room. The bathroom used by children is off of the entryway to the home near the laundry room.

Exiting information (including second floor and basement): There are four exits in this child care family home. The first exit is the front door which provides egress to the front yard. The second exit is the back door in the kitchen which provides egress to the back yard. The third exit is the door in the playroom which provides egress to the back yard. The fourth exit is in the laundry room which provides egress to the garage and the front yard of the home.

Verification of compliance included direct observations of the physical environment and the program, discussions with staff, and a review of the home's records, including staff records and children's records. Staff records include background checks, medical clearance information, and training information. Children's records include child information cards and child in care statements/receipts.

The facility is in compliance with all applicable rules and statutes.

I recommend issuance of a regular license to this child care family home (capacity 1-6).
