

## III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

This renewal inspection involved a review of all applicable child care home administrative rules and statutes. Verification of compliance included direct

observations of the physical environment and the program, discussions with staff, and a review of the home's records, including staff records and children's records. Staff records include background checks, medical clearance information, and training information. Children's records include child information cards and child in care statements/receipts.

During the on-site inspection there were six childcare children and one caregiver present. The children participated in free play, screen time and snack time during the on-site. The children were appropriately interacted with and supervised.

Technical assistance was provided: I discussed with Ms. Crawford completed at least 10 hours annually of professional development, complete an updated radon test, submit an updated medical form, and monitor child care children's screen time.

During the inspection, the child care home was found to be in compliance with all applicable rules and statutes except for the following violations:

**R 400.1932**

**Home maintenance and safety.**


**(8) Open-flame devices and candles must not be used, except for birthdays or religious celebrations, and they must be inaccessible to children and extinguished when done.**

Ms. Crawford was burning a candle during child care hours.

A corrective action plan was requested and approved on 05/26/2022. It is expected that the corrective action plan be implemented within the specified time frames as outlined in the approved plan. A follow-up evaluation may be made to verify compliance. Should the corrections not be implemented in the specified time, it may be necessary to reevaluate the status of your license.

#### **IV. RECOMMENDATION**

I recommend issuance of a regular license to this child care family home (capacity 1-6).
