

Staff records include background checks, medical clearance information, and training information. Children's records include child information cards and child in care statements/receipts.


During the on-site inspection there were three child care children, the licensee and the licensee's 3-year-old daughter present. The child care children were having nap time. They were awakened and allowed to transition to free play. All children were being appropriately interacted with and supervised.

Technical assistance was provided regarding Ms. Veldhouse's updated medical. She has an appointment in October 2022 and will submit the medical document as soon as possible.

The facility is in compliance with all applicable rules and statutes.

I recommend issuance of a regular license to this child care family home (capacity 1-6).
