Dear Ms. Kieft:

This letter is a follow-up to the Department's findings regarding the interim inspection conducted at your home on 06/21/2023. The purpose of this inspection was to determine compliance with applicable licensing statutes and administrative rules for Family and Group Child Care Homes.

During this onsite inspection, I observed outdoor play and dismissal. I did not observe any safety concerns.

The violations that were found are:

**R 400.1945                      Emergency; plan; drill.**

(4) Fire drills must be practiced while children are in care at least once quarterly, and a written record that includes the date and time it takes to evacuate must be maintained.

Ms. Kieft did not ensure that fire drills were practiced while children are in care at least once quarterly, and a written record that includes the date and time it takes to evacuate is maintained. There were no fire drills completed between January 2022 through August 2022.

**Technical assistance and consultation was provided at the time of the exit conference. The following was addressed:**

R 400.1907(1)(a) Review child information cards to ensure that the parents have included all of the required information

Due to the violations, you must send us a corrective action plan by 7/25/2019. You can use our [corrective action plan](#) form or create your own.

If you need help writing the corrective action plan, please contact me. If you do not send a corrective action plan, you may face disciplinary action. The corrective action plan must include the following:

- How compliance with each rule will be achieved.
- Who is directly responsible for implementing the corrective action for each violation.
- Specific time frames for each violation as to when the correction will be completed or implemented.
- How continuing compliance will be maintained once compliance is achieved.
- The signature of the responsible party and a date.
