III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

This renewal inspection involved a review of all applicable child care home administrative rules and statutes. Verification of compliance included direct observations of the physical environment and the program, discussions with staff,

and a review of the home's records, including staff records and children's records. Staff records include background checks, medical clearance information, and training information. Children's records include child information cards and child in care statements/receipts.

During the inspection, the child care home was found to be in compliance with all applicable rules and statutes except for the following violations:

R 400.1907 Child's records.

(1) Prior to a child's initial attendance, a licensee shall obtain the following documents:

(a) A completed child information card on a form provided by the department or a comparable substitute approved by the department.

Ms. Taylor did not ensure that child information cards were completed prior to a child's initial attendance. Two child information cards were reviewed, and they were both missing employer name and telephone numbers.

R 400.1945 Emergency; plan; drill.

1) An applicant or licensee shall have a written emergency response plan for the care of children that must be posted in a conspicuous location within the child care home.

The plan must address the following types of emergencies:

(e) Crisis management including, but not limited to, all of the following:

(i) Intruders.

(ii) Active shooters.

(iii) Bomb threats.

(iv) Other man- or woman-caused events.

Ms. Taylor did not ensure that the crisis management plan included a plan for bomb threats. Ms. Taylor was provided with a sample emergency plan, and she agreed to add a bomb threat plan to her emergency plans.

A corrective action plan was requested and approved on 12/07/2022. It is expected that the corrective action plan be implemented within the specified time frames as outlined in the approved plan. A follow-up evaluation may be made to verify compliance. Should the corrections not be implemented in the specified time, it may be necessary to reevaluate the status of your license.

IV. RECOMMENDATION

I recommend issuance of a regular license to this child care family home (capacity 1-6).
