III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

This renewal inspection involved a review of all applicable child care home administrative rules and statutes. Verification of compliance included direct

observations of the physical environment and the program, discussions with staff, and a review of the home's records, including staff records and children's records. Staff records include background checks, medical clearance information, and training information. Children's records include child information cards and child in care statements/receipts.

At the time of the on-site inspection I provided technical assistance to Ms. Aho regarding the following Child Care Homes Licensing Rules:

R400.1905(6) Training. Ms. Aho must have documentation of child care staff member TL's health and safety trainings.

R400.1915(2) Indoor space; play equipment and materials. Ms. Aho will get prior approval of space prior to using it for child care.

R400.1943(3)(b) Exit requirements for each floor level used by children. The exit window upstairs must be clearly identified.

During the inspection, the child care home was found to be in compliance with all applicable rules and statutes except for the following violations:

R 400.1919 Communicable disease; immunization; mental and physical health; physician attestation; tuberculosis.

(2) A licensee shall obtain from a child care staff member and a child care assistant a written statement, signed by a licensed physician or his or her designee within 1 year prior to caring for children, that attests to the child care staff member's or child care assistant's mental and physical health. The attestation must be renewed at the time of subsequent renewals of the child care home's license.

Ms. Aho did not have a written statement for her child care staff member.

R 400.1919 Communicable disease; immunization; mental and physical health; physician attestation; tuberculosis.

(3) An applicant, licensee, child care staff member, child care assistant, and a member of the household who is age 14 or older shall provide written evidence of freedom from communicable tuberculosis (TB) prior to caring for children or living in the child care home.

Ms. Aho did not have written evidence for her child care staff member and MHM.

R 400.1944 Smoke detectors; fire extinguishers.

(1) Operable smoke detectors approved by a nationally recognized testing laboratory must be installed and maintained on each floor of the home, including the basement, and in all sleeping areas and bedrooms used by children in care.

Bedroom 1 on the second level used by children for sleeping did not have a smoke detector. The smoke detector on the second level was in the hallway.

R 400.1944 Smoke detectors; fire extinguishers.

(3) A home shall have at least 1 functioning multipurpose fire extinguisher, with a rating of 2A-10BC or larger, properly mounted not higher than 5 feet from the floor to the top of the fire extinguisher, on each floor level approved for child use.

Ms. Aho did not have a fire extinguisher on the second level.

A corrective action plan was requested and approved on 12/13/2022. It is expected that the corrective action plan be implemented within the specified time frames as outlined in the approved plan. A follow-up evaluation may be made to verify compliance. Should the corrections not be implemented in the specified time, it may be necessary to reevaluate the status of your license.

IV. RECOMMENDATION

I recommend issuance of a regular license to this child care home (capacity 1-7).
