III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

This renewal inspection involved a review of all applicable child care home administrative rules and statutes. Verification of compliance included direct observations of the physical environment and the program, discussions with staff, and a review of the home's records, including staff records and children's records. Staff records include background checks, medical clearance information, and training information. Children's records include child information cards and child in care statements/receipts.

During the inspection, I observed Ms. Bowers and her assistant caregiver positively interacting with children. The children were served pizza rolls, French fries, and cucumbers for lunch. I provided technical assistance for the following family and group child care homes licensing rules: R 400.1907(1)(a), R 400.1907(1)(b) and R 400.1941.

During the inspection, the child care home was found to be in compliance with all applicable rules and statutes except for the following violations:

R 400.1908 Capacity.

(1) The licensee shall ensure that the actual number of unrelated children in care at any 1 time does not exceed the number of children for which the child care home is licensed, not more than 6 children for a family child care home and not more than 12 children for a group child care home.

Ms. Bowers had seven children in care.

R 400.1932 Home maintenance and safety.

(2) All dangerous and hazardous materials or items must be stored securely and out of the reach of children.

There were hazardous materials including chemicals such as cleaning products were accessible to children.

IV. RECOMMENDATION

I recommend issuance of a regular license to the child care family home (capacity 1-6).
