- How continuing compliance will be maintained once compliance is achieved.

- The signature of the responsible party and a date.

III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

This renewal inspection involved a review of all applicable child care home administrative rules and statutes. Verification of compliance included direct observations of the physical environment and the program, discussions with staff, and a review of the home's records, including staff records and children's records.

Staff records include background checks, medical clearance information, and training information. Children's records include child information cards and child in care statements/receipts. During the onsite inspection, I observed Mrs. Kudo play a clean up song on the piano and all the children actively participated in putting the toys and materials away. After clean up time, the children washed their hands then had snack at the tables in the playroom. I provided technical assistance for the following child care rules and regulations: R 400.1925(1)(b) and R 400.1934(4).

During the inspection, the child care home was found to be in compliance with all applicable rules and statutes except for the following violations:

R 400.1906 Records of a licensee; child care staff member; child care assistant.

(1) A licensee shall maintain a file for each child care staff member and each child care assistant that includes all of the following:

(c) A statement signed by a licensed physician or his or her designee that attests to the individual's mental and physical health., and which must be updated as follows:

(i) For an applicant or licensee, within 1 year before issuance of the initial license and at the time of subsequent renewals.

Mrs. Kudo did not have a completed physical at the time of the renewal inspection.

R 400.1944 Smoke detectors; fire extinguishers.

(3) A home shall have at least 1 functioning multipurpose fire extinguisher, with a rating of 2A-10BC or larger, properly mounted not higher than 5 feet from the floor to the top of the fire extinguisher, on each floor level approved for child use.

The fire extinguisher was not mounted less than 5 feet from the floor.

IV. RECOMMENDATION

Upon receipt of an acceptable corrective action plan, I recommend issuance of a regular license to this child care family home (capacity 1-6).
