III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

A. Description of Facility

Ms. Vanschalkwyk lives in a ranch style home located on a residential street in White Lake.

Rooms and levels approved for child care use:

The living room and kitchen on the main floor are approved for child care use. The children will use the bathroom off the hallway.

Areas not approved:

The three bedrooms, office, and basement are not approved for use.

Ages of children served:

Ms. Vanschalkwyk will provide care for children ages birth to 12 years.

Equipment:

Ms. Vanschalkwyk has a sufficient amount and variety of toys and equipment for the ages and number of children served. Children will rest/nap on cots and porta-cribs.

Proposed days and hours of operation:

The child care home will be open Monday through Friday from 7:30 am to 5:30 pm.

Previous or concurrent licenses, including children's foster care:

Ms. Vanschalkwyk holds no previous or concurrent licenses.

Exiting information (including second floor and basement):

Children will exit out the front door leading to the front yard, or the back sliding door leading to the deck, which has stairs down to the backyard.

Outdoor play area description:

The children will play in the unfenced backyard. The backyard has a climbing structure placed over rubber mulch material. The backyard backs up to a wooded area. Ms. Vanschalkwyk will provide direct supervision of the children when they are engaging in outdoor activities. There are no hazards in the outdoor play area.

Additional information:

I recommend issuance of an original license to this child care home (capacity 1-6).


