Dear Mrs. VanderWall:

This letter is a follow-up to the Department's findings regarding the interim inspection conducted at your home on 02/25/2021. The purpose of this inspection was to determine compliance with applicable licensing statutes and administrative rules for Family and Group Child Care Homes.

The violations that were found are:

R 400.1905

Training.

(3) A licensee shall ensure that child care staff members and child care assistants, prior to caring for children, have training that includes information on all of the following:

(b) Recognition of and the reporting of child abuse and neglect.

Mrs. VanderWall did not complete the required Health and Safety Training that included training on recognition of and the reporting of child abuse and neglect.

R 400.1905

Training.

(4) Within 90 days after receiving a child care license or of being hired at a child care home, a licensee, a child care staff member, and a child care assistant shall complete training on all of the following topics:

(d) Handling and storage of hazardous materials and the appropriate disposal of biocontaminants.

Mrs. VanderWall did not complete the required Health and Safety Training that included training on handling and storage of hazardous materials and the appropriate disposal of biocontaminants.

R 400.1905 Training.

(4) Within 90 days after receiving a child care license or of being hired at a child care home, a licensee, a child care staff member, and a child care assistant shall complete training on all of the following topics:

(e) Precautions in transporting children.

Mrs. VanderWall did not complete the required Health and Safety Training that included training on precautions in transporting children.

R 400.1905 Training.

(4) Within 90 days after receiving a child care license or of being hired at a child care home, a licensee, a child care staff member, and a child care assistant shall complete training on all of the following topics:

(f) Building and physical premises safety.

Mrs. VanderWall did not complete the required Health and Safety Training that included training on building and physical premises safety.

R 400.1905 Training.

(4) Within 90 days after receiving a child care license or of being hired at a child care home, a licensee, a child care staff member, and a child care assistant shall complete training on all of the following topics:

(g) All hazards emergency preparedness and response planning.

Mrs. VanderWall did not complete the required Health and Safety Training that included training on all hazards emergency preparedness and response planning.

Due to the violations, you must send us a corrective action plan by 03/22/2021. You can use our [corrective action plan](#) form or create your own.

If you need help writing the corrective action plan, please contact me. If you do not send a corrective action plan, you may face disciplinary action. The corrective action plan must include the following:

- How compliance with each rule will be achieved.
- Who is directly responsible for implementing the corrective action for each violation.
- Specific time frames for each violation as to when the correction will be completed or implemented.
- How continuing compliance will be maintained once compliance is achieved.
- The signature of the responsible party and a date.

Upon receipt of an acceptable corrective action plan, there will be no change to your license status.
