III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

This renewal inspection involved a review of all applicable child care home administrative rules and statutes. Verification of compliance included direct observations of the physical environment and the program, discussions with staff, and a review of the home's records, including staff records and children's records. Staff records include background checks, medical clearance information, and training information. Children's records include child information cards and child in care statements/receipts.

During my on-site inspection I observed children engaged in free play, an infant sleeping, and Ms. Buitendorp changing diapers. The home was clean, organized, and there was a variety of age-appropriate materials and equipment for the children to access. Ms. Buitendorp interacted with children in a positive and nurturing manner. She was providing appropriate care and supervision. She used redirection and problem solving as positive discipline strategies. All home and child records were organized and complete. Ms. Buitendorp has completed more than the required annual trainings hours.

The facility is in compliance with all applicable rules and statutes.

IV. RECOMMENDATION

I recommend issuance of a regular license to this child care family home (capacity 1-6).
