

III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS


This renewal inspection involved a review of all applicable child care home administrative rules and statutes. Verification of compliance included direct observations of the physical environment and the program, discussions with staff, and a review of the home's records, including staff records and children's records. Staff records include background checks, medical clearance information, and training information. Children's records include child information cards and child in care statements/receipts.

I observed Ms. Greene providing direct supervision of the children napping during rest time upon my arrival. I observed safe sleep practices being utilized. I observed Ms. Greene providing comfort to an infant who had become fussy. I observed the infant engaged in tummy time activities. I observed children preparing for snack time. I observed the caregiver, parents, and children during pick up time. The children appeared happy and well bonded to the licensee. The home was clean and safe for child care use. Required records were organized and readily available for review.

The facility is in compliance with all applicable rules and statutes.

IV. RECOMMENDATION

I recommend issuance of a regular license to this child care family home (capacity 1-6).
