### III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

This renewal inspection involved a review of all applicable child care home administrative rules and statutes. Verification of compliance included direct observations of the physical environment and the program, discussions with staff, and a review of the home's records, including staff records and children's records. Staff records include background checks, medical clearance information, and training information. Children's records include child information cards and child in care statements/receipts.

During the onsite inspection, I observed four children in care transitioning from napping to snack time. Ms. Zahn provided snack and provided praise to children in care for eating snack quietly and using appropriate table manners. All four children appeared happy with and well-bonded to Ms. Zahn. Required records were organized, readily available for review, and easily accessible.

The facility is in compliance with all applicable rules and statutes.

### IV. RECOMMENDATION

I recommend issuance of a regular license to this child care family home.
