

The basement has a window and stairs leading up to the main floor. The basement is not approved however may be used as a storm shelter.

III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS


This renewal inspection involved a review of all applicable child care home administrative rules and statutes. Verification of compliance included direct observations of the physical environment and the program, discussions with staff, and a review of the home's records, including staff records and children's records. Staff records include background checks, medical clearance information, and training information. Children's records include child information cards and child in care statements/receipts.

During the unannounced onsite inspection, I observed Ms. Aldrich providing direct supervision of children napping during rest time upon my arrival. I observed safe sleep practices being utilized. I observed two infants playing during tummy time and in an activity saucer. I observed diapering and proper handwashing techniques being utilized. I observed children engaged in free play activities. The children appeared happy and well bonded to the licensee. Required records were organized and readily available for review. The home was clean and safe for child care use.

The facility is in compliance with all applicable rules and statutes

IV. RECOMMENDATION

I recommend issuance of a regular license to this child care family home (capacity 1-6).
