

Approved child use space: The kitchen, dining room and front living room on the main level of the home are approved for child care use. The three bedrooms on the upper level of the home are used for napping. The lower level large family room is approved for child care use. There is a bathroom on the main level and the upper level for child care use. There is another upper level addition of the home that is not approved for child care use.

Exiting information (including second floor and basement): There are three remote exits; the front door, back slider and garage door which are each marked as exits and lead to outside. The upper level has egress windows and stairs leading down the the main floor. The lower level has egress windows and steps leading up to the main floor.

III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS


This renewal inspection involved a review of all applicable child care home administrative rules and statutes. Verification of compliance included direct observations of the physical environment and the program, discussions with staff, and a review of the home's records, including staff records and children's records. Staff records include background checks, medical clearance information, and training information. Children's records include child information cards and child in care statements/receipts.

During the on site inspection, I observed children napping during rest time upon arrival. I observed older children in the swimming pool while being directly supervised. I observed snack time. I observed children engaged in outdoor play activities. The children appeared happy and well bonded to the caregivers. Required records were organized and readily available. The home was clean and safe for child care use.

The facility is in compliance with all applicable rules and statutes.

IV. RECOMMENDATION

I recommend issuance of a regular license to this child care family home (capacity 1-6).
