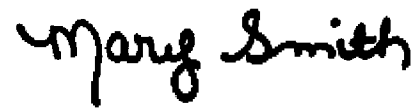

III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

This renewal inspection involved a review of all applicable child care home administrative rules and statutes. Verification of compliance included direct observations of the physical environment and the program, discussions with staff, and a review of the home's records, including staff records and children's records. Staff records include background checks, medical clearance information, and training information. Children's records include child information cards and child in care statements/receipts.

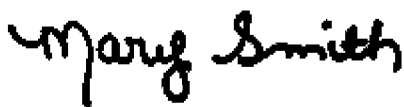
Technical Assistance: I provided technical assistance regarding R400.1934(4). Ms. Howe did not have the results of her radon test available on-site. Ms. Howe understands that a radon test must be completed every four years at the time of the renewal. Ms. Howe did begin the radon test however did not have the results back. Ms. Howe will submit the results to the department as soon as she receives them.

I observed Ms. Howe providing direct supervision of children playing outside upon my arrival. The children were observed playing with age-appropriate toys. I observed one child resting during nap time. I observed hand washing and snack time. I observed children engaged in free play activities. The children appeared happy and well bonded to the licensee. The home was clean and safe for child care use. Required records were organized and readily available.

The facility is in compliance with all applicable rules and statutes.

IV. RECOMMENDATION

I recommend issuance of a regular license to this child care family home (Capacity 1-6).
