Main level; Two bedrooms are approved for child care use for overnight care and daytime naps. The bathroom on the lower level and main level of the home are available for child care use.

Exiting information (including second floor and basement): There are three remote exits; the front and patio door, which leads to the backyard. The lower level has stairs leading up to the main floor and emergency window meeting the licensing requirements for size and location.

Language for Full Inspection

This renewal inspection involved a review of all applicable child care home administrative rules and statutes. Verification of compliance included direct observations of the physical environment and the program, discussions with staff, and a review of the home's records, including staff records and children's records. Staff records include background checks, medical clearance information, and training information. Children's records include child information cards and child in care statements/receipts.

During the onsite inspection, I observed the licensee provide direct supervision to child in care engaging in free play activities. Required records were organized and readily available for review. The home was clean and safe for child care use.

Technical Assistance: I provided technical assistance for the following:


