

The basement has two remote exits; a window and stairs leading up to the main level. There is no upper level.

III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS


This renewal inspection involved a review of all applicable child care home administrative rules and statutes. Verification of compliance included direct observations of the physical environment and the program, discussions with staff, and a review of the home's records, including staff records and children's records. Staff records include background checks, medical clearance information, and training information. Children's records include child information cards and child in care statements/receipts.

During the on-site inspection, I observed no children in care upon arrival other than Ms. Gardner's own children. I observed one child and parent during drop off. I observed the one child during free play activities. The child appeared happy and well bonded to the licensee. The home was clean and safe for child care use. Required records were organized and readily available.

The facility is in compliance with all applicable rules and statutes.

IV. RECOMMENDATION

I recommend issuance of a original license to this child care family home (capacity 1-6).
