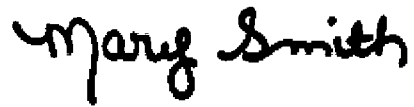

Approved child use space: The living room and dining room located on the main floor of the home are approved for child care use. The back bedroom located on the upper level is approved for napping and overnight care. Ms. Harris has a bunk bed that has two twin sized beds available for overnight care. Ms. Harris is aware that if she is going to care for more than two children overnight, she will need to purchase additional beds. Ms. Harris is aware that one caregiving staff person must be on the same floor as sleeping children. Ms. Harris is not approved to care for children under the age of two. There is a half bathroom located off the living room on the main floor for children's use. There is a full bathroom located on the upper level for children's use.

Exiting information (including second floor and basement): The main level has two remote exits; the front door and back door and each are marked as exits and lead to outside. The upper level has two remote exits; a window and stairs leading down to the main level. The basement has two remote exits; a window and stairs leading up to the main level.

III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

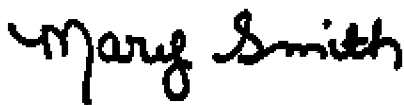
This renewal inspection involved a review of all applicable child care home administrative rules and statutes. Verification of compliance included direct observations of the physical environment and the program, discussions with staff, and a review of the home's records, including staff records and children's records. Staff records include background checks, medical clearance information, and training information. Children's records include child information cards and child in care statements/receipts.

During the onsite inspection, I observed the licensee providing direct supervision of children napping during rest time upon arrival. I also observed two older children engaged in quiet activities. I observed the licensee, a parent, and a child during pick up time. The children appeared happy and well bonded to the licensee. Required records were organized and readily available for review. The home was clean and safe for children's use.

The facility is in compliance with all applicable rules and statutes.

IV. RECOMMENDATION

I recommend issuance of a regular license to this child care family home (Capacity 1-6).
