### III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

This renewal inspection involved a review of all applicable child care home administrative rules and statutes. Verification of compliance included direct observations of the physical environment and the program, discussions with staff, and a review of the home's records, including staff records and children's records. Staff records include background checks, medical clearance information, and training information. Children's records include child information cards and child in care statements/receipts.

During the inspection, the child care home was found to be in compliance with all applicable rules and statutes except for the following violations:

#### **R 400.1905            Training**

(9) When the department of licensing and regulatory affairs or the department of education publishes a notice that a new health and safety update document or a new health and safety update training activity has been published on MiRegistry, the licensee shall ensure that all personnel read and acknowledge the document or complete the activity within 6 months of the notice.

Ms. Bruzdowski had not completed the refresher trainings as required by this rule for 2021 or 2022. Links have been provided for Ms. Bruzdowski to complete them.

#### **R 400.1906            Records of a licensee; child care staff member; child care assistant.**

(1) A licensee shall maintain a file for each child care staff member and each child care assistant that includes all of the following:

(c) A statement signed by a licensed physician or his or her designee that attests to the individual's mental and physical health., and which must be updated as follows:

(i) For an applicant or licensee, within 1 year before issuance of the initial license and at the time of subsequent renewals.

At the time of renewal, Ms. Bruzdowski did not have an updated statement signed by a physician attesting to her mental and physical health.

**R 400.1919                      Communicable disease; immunization; mental and physical health; physician attestation; tuberculosis.**

(3) An applicant, licensee, child care staff member, child care assistant, and a member of the household who is age 14 or older shall provide written evidence of freedom from communicable tuberculosis (TB) prior to caring for children or living in the child care home.

A member of the household who turned 14 years old did not have a TB test completed.

**R 400.1932                      Home maintenance and safety.**

(2) All dangerous and hazardous materials or items must be stored securely and out of the reach of children.

The safety latch to the kitchen cupboard was no longer working or in good repair. The cupboard was beneath the kitchen sink and stored cleaning supplies. These hazardous materials were not stored securely and out of the reach of children.

A corrective action plan was requested and approved on 09/12/2023. It is expected that the corrective action plan be implemented within the specified time frames as outlined in the approved plan. A follow-up evaluation may be made to verify compliance. Should the corrections not be implemented in the specified time, it may be necessary to reevaluate the status of your license.

**IV. RECOMMENDATION**

I recommend issuance of a regular license to this child care family home (capacity 1-6).
