The family home has three cats.

There is an in-ground swimming pool in the backyard. There is a tall privacy fence around the pool with gates that are more than four feet high and locked so children cannot access the pool area. The sliding glass door in the family room leading to the pool area has a safety bar up high that cannot be accessed by young children. The side garage door has a hook up high so children cannot unlock the door and enter the pool area while playing outdoors.

There is a wood burning fireplace in the living room but it is not used during child care hours.

III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

This renewal inspection involved a review of all applicable child care home administrative rules and statutes. Verification of compliance included direct observations of the physical environment and the program, discussions with staff, and a review of the home's records, including staff records and children's records. Staff records include background checks, medical clearance information, and training information. Children's records include child information cards and child in care statements/receipts.

During the inspection, the child care home was found to be in compliance with all applicable rules and statutes except for the following violations:

R 400.1905

Training

(9) When the department of licensing and regulatory affairs or the department of education publishes a notice that a new health and safety update document or a new health and safety update training activity has been published on MiRegistry, the licensee shall ensure that all personnel read and acknowledge the document or complete the activity within 6 months of the notice.

The licensee did not complete a health and safety update published by the department from 2021 in MiRegistry within six months of the notice.

A corrective action plan was requested and approved on 10/18/2022. It is expected that the corrective action plan be implemented within the specified time frames as outlined in the approved plan. A follow-up evaluation may be made to verify compliance. Should the corrections not be implemented in the specified time, it may be necessary to reevaluate the status of your license.

IV. RECOMMENDATION

I recommend issuance of a regular license to this child care family home (capacity 1-6).
