During the on-site inspection, children were observed engaging in a variety of developmentally appropriate activities. The facility is equipped with a variety of developmentally appropriate equipment. The child care staff member and child interactions were very nurturing and positive. Meal preparation was also observed.

The facility is in compliance with all applicable rules and statutes.

IV. RECOMMENDATION

I recommend issuance of a regular license to this child care family home (capacity 1-6).
