Dear Ms. Crawford:

This letter is a follow-up to the Department's findings regarding the interim inspection conducted at your home on 02/17/2023. The purpose of this inspection was to determine compliance with applicable licensing statutes and administrative rules for Family and Group Child Care Homes.

The violations that were found are:

R 400.1945 Emergency; plan; drill.

(1) An applicant or licensee shall have a written emergency response plan for the care of children that must be posted in a conspicuous location within the child care home.

The plan must address the following types of emergencies:

- (a) Fire evacuation.
- (b) Tornado watches and warnings.
- (c) Serious accident or injury.
- (d) Water emergencies, if applicable.
- (e) Crisis management including, but not limited to, all of

the following:

- (i) Intruders.
- (ii) Active shooters.
- (iii) Bomb threats.
- (iv) Other man- or woman-caused events.

Emergency plans to address fire, tornado, serious accident or injury and crisis management were not posted in the home.

R 400.1945 Emergency; plan; drill.

(4) Fire drills must be practiced while children are in care at least once quarterly, and a written record that includes the date and time it takes to evacuate must be maintained.

Ms. Crawford did not practice fire drills at least quarterly in 2022.

(5) At least 2 tornado drills must be practiced while children are in care between March and November, and a written record of these drills that includes the date must be maintained.

Ms. Crawford did not practice at least 2 tornado drills between March and November.

- Who is directly responsible for implementing the corrective action for each violation.
- Specific time frames for each violation as to when the correction will be completed or implemented.
- How continuing compliance will be maintained once compliance is achieved.
- The signature of the responsible party and a date.
