Dear Ms Davison:

This letter is a follow-up to the Department's findings regarding the interim inspection conducted at your home on 06/27/2022. The purpose of this inspection was to determine compliance with applicable licensing statutes and administrative rules for Family and Group Child Care Homes.

The violations that were found are:

R400.1905(3)(b) Training.

(3) A licensee shall ensure that child care staff members and child care assistants, prior to caring for children, have training that includes information on all of the following:

(b) Recognition of and the reporting of child abuse and neglect.

Licensee has not completed Health and Safety course 2, which includes the recognition of and the reporting of child abuse and neglect.

R400.1905(3)(c) Training.

(3) A licensee shall ensure that child care staff members and child care assistants, prior to caring for children, have training that includes information on all of the following:

(c) Prevention of shaken baby syndrome, abusive head trauma, and child maltreatment.

Licensee has not completed Health and Safety course 2, which includes Prevention of shaken baby syndrome, abusive head trauma, and child maltreatment.

R400.1905(4)

Training.

(4) Within 90 days after receiving a child care license or of being hired at a child care home, a licensee, a child care staff member, and a child care assistant shall complete training on all of the following topics:

- (a) Child development.
- (b) Administration of medication.
- (c) Prevention of and response to emergencies due to food and allergic reactions.
- (d) Handling and storage of hazardous materials and the appropriate disposal of biocontaminants.
- (e) Precautions in transporting children.
- (f) Building and physical premises safety.
- (g) All hazards emergency preparedness and response planning.

Licensee has not completed Health and Safety course 1 or course 2, which includes:

- Child Development
- Administration of medication
- Prevention of and response to emergencies due to food and allergic reactions
- Handling and storage of hazardous materials and the appropriate disposal of bio contaminants
- Precautions in transporting children
- Building and physical premises safety
- All hazards emergency preparedness and response planning.

On 06/27/22, you gave us an acceptable written corrective action plan.

On 06/27/22 during an interim inspection, there were two children present. Upon arrival the children were at the table eating breakfast and then transitioned downstairs to the basement and begin playing with various materials. During the inspection I observed Ms. Davison interact with the children appropriately.


