

## III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

This renewal inspection involved a review of all applicable child care home administrative rules and statutes. Verification of compliance included direct

observations of the physical environment and the program, discussions with staff, and a review of the home's records, including staff records and children's records. Staff records include background checks, medical clearance information, and training information. Children's records include child information cards and child in care statements/receipts.

The facility is in compliance with all applicable rules and statutes except the following:

**R400.1932 Home Maintenance and safety**

All dangerous and hazardous materials or items must be stored securely and out of the reach of children.

During the onsite inspection, Ms. Williams had hazardous materials in an unlocked cabinet that was accessible to children in care.

**R400.1919(3) Communicable disease; immunization; mental and physical health; physician attestation; tuberculosis.**

An applicant, licensee, child care staff member, child care assistant, and a member of the household who is age 14 or older shall provide written evidence of freedom from communicable tuberculosis (TB) prior to caring for children or living in the child care home.

During the onsite inspection, there were two of Ms. Williams' grandchildren who semi-resides in the licensed home. They are in her home during the day and overnight the majority of the time, according to Ms. Williams.


**R400.1934(4) Heating; ventilation; lighting; radon**

During the onsite inspection, Ms. Williams had not had a radon test since 2017.

A corrective action plan was requested and approved on 01/19/2023. It is expected that the corrective action plan be implemented within the specified time frames as outlined in the approved plan. A follow-up evaluation may be made to verify compliance. Should the corrections not be implemented in the specified time, it may be necessary to reevaluate the status of your license.

**IV. RECOMMENDATION**

I recommend issuance of a regular license to this child care family home (capacity 1-6).
