Dear Ms. Almani:

This letter is a follow-up to the Department's findings regarding the interim inspection conducted at your home on 03/27/2023. The purpose of this inspection was to determine compliance with applicable licensing statutes and administrative rules for Family and Group Child Care Homes.

On 3/27/2023, there were no children present. The licensee was closed that day.

The violations that were found are:

R 400.1905 Training

(9) When the department of licensing and regulatory affairs or the department of education publishes a notice that a new health and safety update document or a new health and safety update training activity has been published on MiRegistry, the licensee shall ensure that all personnel read and acknowledge the document or complete the activity within 6 months of the notice.

On 3/27/2023, the licensee did not take the 2022 Health and Safety Refresher course.

R 400.1925

Comprehensive background check; fingerprinting.

(1) Pursuant to section 5n of the act, MCL 722.115n, prior to an individual having any unsupervised contact with children, the department shall determine the individual's eligibility to be any of the following:

(b) An adult member of the household.

On 3/27/2023, the licensee's daughter had not been fingerprinted and connected to the facility. The licensee stated that her daughter was fingerprinted for her work but not aware she would need to be fingerprinted again for her license.

Technical assistance was provided regarding updating emergency plans to include a crisis management plan. We also discussed making sure that each adult household member had a separate consent and disclosure form on file. The licensee will have her daughter fingerprinted and will get a copy of her TB test and will place all documents on file. The licensee was using outdated child information cards and child in care statements. She will have families fill out new copies on the new forms.

On 03/27/2023, you gave us an acceptable written corrective action plan.


