- Specific time frames for each violation as to when the correction will be completed or implemented.
- How continuing compliance will be maintained once compliance is achieved.
- The signature of the responsible party and a date.

III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

This renewal inspection involved a review of all applicable child care home administrative rules and statutes. Verification of compliance included direct observations of the physical environment and the program, discussions with staff, and a review of the home's records, including staff records and children's records. Staff records include background checks, medical clearance information, and

training information. Children's records include child information cards and child in care statements/receipts.

During the inspection, the child care home was found to be in compliance with all applicable rules and statutes except for the following violations:

R 400.1907 Child's records.

(1) Prior to a child's initial attendance, a licensee shall obtain the following documents:

(a) A completed child information card on a form provided by the department or a comparable substitute approved by the department.

Five of six child information cards were incomplete missing date of admission, employer name, parent signature and were not updated and initialed by parent after year of enrollment.

R 400.1925 Comprehensive background check; fingerprinting.

(2) An applicant or licensee shall do all of the following:

(a) Ensure that each individual who requires an eligibility determination pursuant to subrule (1) of this rule completes, signs, and submits all of the information required in subrule (5) of this rule, and in subrule (6) of this rule if applicable, on a form prescribed by the department. The forms are available on the department's website for the child care background check system, www.michigan.gov/ccbc. The form(s) must be signed and dated prior to the individual's appointment to be fingerprinted.

The licensee did not have consent and disclosure statements on file at the child care family home.

R 400.1933 Water supply; sewage disposal; water temperature.

(4) Hot water temperature must not exceed 120 degrees Fahrenheit at water faucets accessible to children.

The hot water temperature was 138.2 degrees Fahrenheit in the bathroom.

R 400.1941 Heat-producing equipment.

(2) Combustible materials and equipment must not be stored within 4 feet of furnaces, other flame or heat-producing equipment, or fuel-fired water heaters.

There was kitty litter, bleach, and mop buckets stored within 4 feet of the furnace and hot water heater.

R 400.1945 Emergency; plan; drill.

1) An applicant or licensee shall have a written emergency response plan for the care of children that must be posted in a conspicuous location within the child care home. The plan must address the following types of emergencies:

(e) Crisis management including, but not limited to, all of the following:

- (i) Intruders.
- (ii) Active shooters.
- (iii) Bomb threats.
- (iv) Other man-or woman-caused events.

There was no written emergency response plan regarding crisis management.

Consultation was provided regarding 2% milk being served instead of whole milk for children under two and 1% or skim for children over age two. Repost discipline and recall list. Locate and print eligibility letters.

IV. RECOMMENDATION

Upon receipt of an acceptable corrective action plan, I recommend issuance of a regular license to this child care family home (capacity 1-6).
