Findings of the Inspection

The purpose of the Interim inspection was to determine compliance with applicable licensing statutes and administrative rules for child care Family Home.

On 4/10/2024, during my onsite inspection, there were three children present and one child care staff member. The Licesnee was not present. Children were finishing eating breakfast and playing with various object. The child care staff member was cooking breakfast for student that would be arriving later. Although the staff member was in a separate room then the children, the door way to the kitchen is large and the staff member could still see the children from where she was cooking. After cooking breakfast, the child care staff member sat down with the children to read them a story.

During the Interim inspection, licensing consultant Laura Piacentini found 1 violations. The violations are listed and explained below. Due to the violations, the licensee/licensee designee must send the bureau a [corrective action plan](#) by 5/2/2024. The corrective action plan may be submitted in the [Child Care Hub Information Record Portal \(CCHIRP\)](#). The corrective action plan must include the following:

- How compliance with each rule will be achieved.
- Who is directly responsible for implementing the corrective action for each violation.

- Specific time frames for each violation as to when the correction will be completed or implemented.
- How continuing compliance will be maintained once compliance is achieved.
- The signature of the responsible party and a date.
