## III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

This renewal inspection involved a review of all applicable child care home administrative rules and statutes. Verification of compliance included direct observations of the physical environment and the program, discussions with staff, and a review of the home's records, including staff records and children's records. Staff records include background checks, medical clearance information, and

training information. Children's records include child information cards and child in care statements/receipts.

During the inspection, the child care home was found to be in compliance with all applicable rules and statutes except for the following violations:

**R 400.1907            Child's records.**

**(1) Prior to a child's initial attendance, a licensee shall obtain the following documents:**

**(a) A completed child information card on a form provided by the department or a comparable substitute approved by the department.**

On 3/7/2023, I reviewed all 16 child information records. All 16 records were incomplete. All 16 were missing the date of admission, 4 of the 16 were missing the child's date of birth, 7 of the 16 were missing allergy information, 5 out of 16 were not signed or dated, and 2 out of the 16 were missing physician information.


A corrective action plan was requested and approved on 03/08/2023. It is expected that the corrective action plan be implemented within the specified time frames as outlined in the approved plan. A follow-up evaluation may be made to verify compliance. Should the corrections not be implemented in the specified time, it may be necessary to reevaluate the status of your license.

On 3/7/2023, during an onsite inspection I observed five children, one of whom was the licensee's 2-year-old child. Children were laying down on their cots getting ready for rest time. Two children had a difficult time laying down on their cots. The licensee worked on getting the children to settle down by playing some nursely rhymes and later the tv show cocomelon on tv.

Technical assistance was provided regarding getting the emergency plans posted. The plans were currently only in the licensing notebook. The licensee was in the process of updating the child sign in and out sheets and we talked about making sure the child's first and last name were listed. I also reviewed the 3-step cleaning process for changing tables. Technical assistance was also provided regarding using the newest addition of the child in care statement. The licensee is going to have all families fill out the new child in care statements.

**IV. RECOMMENDATION**

I recommend issuance of a original license to this child care family home (capacity 1-6).
