III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

This renewal inspection involved a review of all applicable child care home administrative rules and statutes. Verification of compliance included direct observations of the physical environment and the program, discussions with staff,

and a review of the home's records, including staff records and children's records. Staff records include background checks, medical clearance information, and training information. Children's records include child information cards and child in care statements/receipts.

The facility is in compliance with all applicable rules and statutes.

Technical assistance was provided regarding cleaning up the back yard. Mulch needs to be put down under the swings, slide and small climber. Licensee stated she would do this before caring for children. There is also a trampoline out in the back. Consultation was provided on moving that away from the other play equipment so that all children know they are not to play on it.


Technical assistance was also provided regarding emergency plan. Licensee had plan but they were not posted. The plans also need to be updated to include how infants and toddlers will be accommodated during each type of emergency. It was also suggested that a specific location was written down for evacuation.

Consultation was provided regarding updating the changing table pad as well as the location of the changing table. Licensee said she will move the changing table back to the living room area and purchases a new pad before caring for children.
