Approved child use space: The main level kitchen, living room, and playroom are approved for child care use.

Exiting information (including second floor and basement): There is a door from the kitchen entry area to the side yard of the home and a door to the garage from the same area. There is also a sliding glass door which exits the living room to a deck and the side yard of the home.

There are two dogs. The children do not have access to one of the dogs.
- Hot tubs or spa pool? No Yes If yes, are there appropriate barriers?

Ms. Bednarick's home is directly across Sunnyside Dr. from Lake Cadillac.
Sunnyside Dr. is a visual barrier between the home and the lake.
- Fireplace or wood burning stove? No Yes If yes, describe.
There is a wood burning stove insert in the living room.
- Fireplace/wood burner in use during child care hours? No Yes If yes, describe barriers to protect children from burns.
Ms. Bednarick has a secure gate across the length of the living room, creating a barrier between the child use space and the fireplace.

III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

This renewal inspection involved a review of all applicable child care home administrative rules and statutes. Verification of compliance included direct observations of the physical environment and the program, discussions with staff, and a review of the home's records, including staff records and children's records. Staff records include background checks, medical clearance information, and training information. Children's records include child information cards and child in care statements/receipts.

During the inspection, Ms. Bednarick cared for the children while we spoke, and I conducted the inspection. The interaction between Ms. Bednarick and the children was appropriate and kind.

During the inspection, the child care home was found to be in compliance with all applicable rules and statutes except for the following violations:

R 400.1907

Child's records.

(1) Prior to a child's initial attendance, a licensee shall obtain the following documents:

(a) A completed child information card on a form provided by the department or a comparable substitute approved by the department.

I reviewed child information cards for four unrelated children. Three cards were missing at date of admission and three cards were missing allergies, special needs, and special instructions. One card was missing parent information and one card was missing a signature and date of signature.

R 400.1925

Comprehensive background check; fingerprinting.

(5) An individual who requires a comprehensive background check pursuant to section 5n of the act, MCL 722.115n, shall submit to the department, on a form prescribed by the department, all personally identifiable information necessary to conduct the comprehensive background check...

Ms. Bednarick did not ensure there was a completed Consent and Disclosure document on file for Household Member, Mr. Jon Bednarick. There was a document on file; however, it was not completed.

R 400.1933 Water supply; sewage disposal; water temperature.

(4) Hot water temperature must not exceed 120 degrees Fahrenheit at water faucets accessible to children.

During the inspection, the temperature of the water at the bathroom sink accessible to children was 130 degrees Fahrenheit.

A corrective action plan was requested and approved on 02/16/2021. It is expected that the corrective action plan be implemented within the specified time frames as outlined in the approved plan. A follow-up evaluation may be made to verify compliance. Should the corrections not be implemented in the specified time, it may be necessary to reevaluate the status of your license.

During the inspection, and/or a follow-up telephone call, I provided technical assistance regarding:

- Emergency plans regarding the newer rules.
- Radon testing every four years.
- Updating discipline policy regarding newer rules.
- Gun cabinets with glass panels are not considered to be commercial gun safes. This type of gun cabinet may only be used to store firearms if a trigger lock or firearm cable lock is properly utilized on the firearm according to manufacturer instructions.
- Maintaining a licensing notebook.

Note: please forward a current radon test to the department for the file.

IV. RECOMMENDATION

I recommend issuance of a regular license to this child care family home (capacity 1-6).
