Ms. Laskowski has two dogs that are chihuauas. They were friendly during the inspection.

Ms. Laskowski has an indoor pool. The pool is located in an area of the home that is not approved for child use. The door to the pool is locked and Ms. Laskowski has an alarm on the door just in case a child would sneak away and open the door.

Ms. Laskowski has a little pond in her yard. This area is separate from the enclosed outdoor play area. There is a brick wall that encloses the pond.

There is a fireplace that is located in a room not approved for child care use.

III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

This renewal inspection involved a review of all applicable child care home administrative rules and statutes. Verification of compliance included direct observations of the physical environment and the program, discussions with staff, and a review of the home's records, including staff records and children's records. Staff records include background checks, medical clearance information, and training information. Children's records include child information cards and child in care statements/receipts.

During the inspection, the child care home was found to be in compliance with all applicable rules and statutes except for the following violations:

R 400.1905 Training.

(1) A licensee shall complete not less than 10 clock hours of training each calendar year related to child development, program planning, and administrative management for a child care business, not including CPR, first aid, and infectious disease, including immunizations, training.

Ms. Laskowski did not complete 10 hours of annual training for 2022.

R 400.1905 Training

(9) When the department of licensing and regulatory affairs or the department of education publishes a notice that a new health and safety update document or a new health and safety update training activity has been published on MiRegistry, the licensee shall ensure that all personnel read and acknowledge the document or complete the activity within 6 months of the notice.

Ms. Laskowski did not complete refresher health and safety course for 2022.

R 400.1906 Records of a licensee; child care staff member; child care assistant.

(1) A licensee shall maintain a file for each child care staff member and each childcare assistant that includes all of the following:

(c) A statement signed by a licensed physician or his or her designee that attests to the individual's mental and physical health., and which must be updated as follows:

(i) For an applicant or licensee, within 1 year before issuance of the initial license and at the time of subsequent renewals.

Ms. Laskowski did not complete a physical at the time of renewal.

R 400.1934 Heating; ventilation; lighting; radon.

(4) A licensee shall test the child care home for the concentration of radon gas before the initial license is issued and every 4 years thereafter at the time of license renewal.

Ms. Laskowski did not complete a radon test every four years at the time of renewal.

A corrective action plan was requested and approved on 05/08/2023. It is expected that the corrective action plan be implemented within the specified time frames as outlined in the approved plan. A follow-up evaluation may be made to verify compliance. Should the corrections not be implemented in the specified time, it may be necessary to reevaluate the status of your license.

Technical assistance was provided regarding home maintenance. There were some spots where paint was peeling. Ms. Laskowski was told to scrape the paint that was accessible to children. The use of gates was discussed with Ms. Laskowski. They are needed at the top and/or bottom of stairway depending on where children are located the home.

IV. RECOMMENDATION

I recommend no change in license status.
