

Approved child use space: The main floor is approved but is used mainly for the bathroom. The basement is approved for child care.

Exiting information (including second floor and basement): The main floor has a front and back door for exiting to the outside. The basement has a stairway that leads to the back door and an egress window located remotely from the stairway.

Approved variances - No Yes Description: A variance was granted on 7/21/22 for Ms. Auger to have a one to seven ratio and her capacity be increased to 14.

Ms. Auger has two dogs. A mixed breed and a labrador retriever. The dogs were very friendly during the inspection. They are kept on the main floor with a gate so they do not have regular acces to the children.

- Fireplace/wood burner in use during child care hours? No Yes If yes, describe barriers to protect children from burns.


III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

This renewal inspection involved a review of all applicable child care home administrative rules and statutes. Verification of compliance included direct observations of the physical environment and the program, discussions with staff, and a review of the home's records, including staff records and children's records. Staff records include background checks, medical clearance information, and training information. Children's records include child information cards and child in care statements/receipts.

The facility is in compliance with all applicable rules and statutes. During the inspection I observed children participating in free play, bodily care, feeding, and pick up of children by parents. Ms. Auger and her child care staff members were attentive to the children and their needs during the inspection. I overheard a father of one of the children tell the Ms. Auger and the child care staff that he "love it there".

IV. RECOMMENDATION

I recommend issuance of a regular license to this child care group home (capacity 7-12).
