II. Purpose of Addendum

Ms. Vink requested that her basement be approved for child use space.

IV. Description of Findings and Conclusions

A. Description of Facility: Ms. Vink resides in a three-bedroom ranch style home. The home is located on Hilltop Drive off Salzburg Road on the west side of Bay City. Zoning approval was authorized by Monitor Township on 8/15/22 by Terry Spencer.

Rooms and levels approved for child care use: Ms. Vink's main level is approved for child care. The rooms consist of the living room, dining room, sun room, basement, and bathroom. The sunroom will only be used during the mild months when the heater is not needed. The baseboard heat vents get very hot and would be a hazard to children if they were to be in the room.

Ms. Vink agreed to monitor the temperature in the basement when in use by child care children. I discussed with Ms. Vink different ways to ensure the temperature in the basement remain at 65 degrees or higher.

Ms. Vink's basement is approximately 50 ft. X 8 ft and 24 ft. X 10 ft. This measures 640 square feet. This is sufficient space for Ms. Vink's capacity of 12.

Areas not approved: The basement and bedrooms are not approved for child care children.

Ages of children served: Ms. Vink will care for children birth through five years.

Equipment: Ms. Vink has a sufficient amount and variety of developmentally appropriate equipment for the capacity of twelve children.

Proposed days and hours of operation: Ms. Vink will operate her child care home Monday through Friday from 6:00 a.m. until 6:00 p.m.

Previous or concurrent licenses, including children's foster care: Ms. Vink has been previously licensed DF090065716 4/95-4/98, Df090095564 1/25/01-6/10/01, DG090096677 6/11/01-11/29/07, and DG090399084 4/24/19 until 8/22/22.

Exiting information (including second floor and basement): There are two front doors on opposite ends of the home that lead to the front yard. The home has a back door and the sunroom has several doors that lead directly to the backyard.

The basement has three exits available. There is an egress window that is located at the one end of the basement and a stairway that leads out to the garage remotely located from the exit window. The third exit located about a quarter way down one side of the basement that leads to a door to the backyard.

Outdoor play area description: Ms. Vink's outdoor play area is located directly behind her home and it is enclosed with a privacy fence. Ms. Vink has no big playground equipment that would require surfacing.
