Dear Ms. Baker:

This letter is a follow-up to the Department's findings regarding the interim inspection conducted at your home on 11/21/2022. The purpose of this inspection was to determine compliance with applicable licensing statutes and administrative rules for Family and Group Child Care Homes.

The violations that were found are:

R 400.1919	Communicable disease; immunization; mental and physical health; physician attestation; tuberculosis.
	(3) An applicant, licensee, child care staff member, child care assistant, and a member of the household who is age 14 or older shall provide written evidence of freedom from communicable tuberculosis (TB) prior to caring for children or living in the child care home.
One adult household member did not have evidence to show freedom from communicable tuberculosis prior to living in the home.	
R 400.1925	Comprehensive background check; fingerprinting.
	(1) Pursuant to section 5n of the act, MCL 722.115n, prior to an individual having any unsupervised contact with children, the department shall determine the individual's eligibility to be any of the following:

	(b) An adult member of the household.
One household member did not complete a comprehensive background check to determine eligibility prior to moving into the child care home.	
R 400.1935	Firearms.
	(1) All firearms must be unloaded and properly stored in a secure, safe, locked environment inaccessible to children during hours of operation or while children are in care at a child care home. A secure and locked environment means a locked commercial gun safe, or a trigger lock installed and locked according to the manufacturer's recommendations to prevent discharge.
One gun safe in the garage containing firearms and ammunition was not locked or made inaccessible to children.	
R 400.1935	Firearms.
	(2) Ammunition must be stored in a separate locked location inaccessible to children during hours of operation or while children are in care at a child care home.
Ammunition was not stored in a separate locked location inaccessible to children.	

Due to the violations, you must send us a corrective action plan by 12/11/2022. You can use our [corrective action plan](#) form or create your own. If you need help writing the corrective action plan, please contact me. If you do not send a corrective action plan, you may face disciplinary action. The corrective action plan must include the following:

- How compliance with each rule will be achieved.
- Who is directly responsible for implementing the corrective action for each violation.
- Specific time frames for each violation as to when the correction will be completed or implemented.
- How continuing compliance will be maintained once compliance is achieved.
- The signature of the responsible party and a date.

Upon receipt of an acceptable corrective action plan, there will be no change to your license status.
