Approved child use space: The home is a bi-level structure. The main floor and the lower level are approved for child use. On the main floor the kitchen, living room, dining room and two bathrooms are approved for child use. The entry way that is between the levels is also approved. On the lower level the living room, one bedroom and one bathroom is approved for child use.

Exiting information (including second floor and basement): There are 3 remote exits in the home. On the main floor there are two exits, the first is located on the west side of the home and leads to the front yard and drive. The second is located on the north side of the home and leads to the garage which leads to the backyard on the east side or the driveway on the west side. On the lower level there is a remote exit to grade on the south east side of the home that leads to the fenced in back yard. The second exit is the small stairway that leads to the landing between levels and has two remote exits as mentioned above.
