- Specific time frames for each violation as to when the correction will be completed or implemented.
- How continuing compliance will be maintained once compliance is achieved.

- The signature of the responsible party and a date.

Upon receipt of an acceptable corrective action plan, a regular license will be issued.

R 400.1919(1)	An applicant shall obtain a written statement, signed by a licensed physician or his or her designee within 1 year before issuance of the initial license, that attests to the applicant's mental and physical health. The attestation must be renewed at the time of subsequent license renewals. <u>Physicals are scheduled, but should always be completed by the time of renewal for licensee and assistants.</u>
R 400.1907(1)(a)	A completed child information card on a form provided by the department or a comparable substitute approved by the department. <u>Newest version available and no N/A can be used for employer details or allergy/special needs.</u>
R 400.1934(5)	The lowest level of the child care home must not have levels of radon gases that exceed 4 picocuries per liter of air, except as provided in subrule (6) of this rule. Documentation of the results must be kept on file in the child care home. <u>New radon test needed.</u>
