Dear Ms. Yoder:

This letter is a follow-up to the Department's findings regarding the interim inspection conducted at your home on 04/20/2022. The purpose of this inspection was to determine compliance with applicable licensing statutes and administrative rules for Family and Group Child Care Homes.

During the inspection, I reviewed fire safety, sleep equipment, child care records, immunizations, MiRegistry trainings, child care staff member interactions with children, tornado/fire drills, criminal background paperwork, diapering/toileting, and programming. There were 10 children present along with child care staff members Ms. Yoder and Ms. May. Both Ms. Yoder and Ms. May were observed being attentive to the child care children. They were both observed verbally encouraging the children, engaging with them during free play, and appropriately redirecting the children during outdoor play. Ms. Yoder has a sufficient amount of developmentally appropriate equipment in the child care home. To promote early math, Ms. Yoder has number and shape charts hanging on the walls in the child care room. The children have access to puzzles, board games, and blocks as well. Ms. Yoder displayed plants that the children are currently growing in the child care room which supports early science. The children learn about plants, animals, and engage in various science experiments throughout the year. Both child care staff members read to the children daily and engage them in various language development activities. The outdoor play area features a climber with an attached slide and swings. I found there to be a sufficient amount of sand surfacing under the climber.

Technical Assistance and Consultation were provided on the following:

- R 400.1907(2)- There were 3 child information cards which need to be updated by the parents.
- I provided guidance to Ms. Wallis on providing more detail to her infant and toddler plans.
- I provided guidance on the active shooter and intruder crisis management plans.

As a result of the inspection, I did not find any rule or law violations.
