R 400.1919(1) & (2) Communicable disease; immunizations; mental and physical health; physician attestation; tuberculosis



III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

This renewal inspection involved a review of all applicable child care home administrative rules and statutes. Verification of compliance included direct observations of the physical environment and the program, discussions with staff, and a review of the home's records, including staff records and children's records. Staff records include background checks, medical clearance information, and training information. Children's records include child information cards and child in care statements/receipts.

During the inspection I observed lunch, handwashing, nap time for the toddler, free choice play. Ms. Yoder and Ms. May were nurturing and responsive to the children's needs and questions.

During the inspection, the child care home was found to be in compliance with all applicable rules and statutes except for the following violations:

R 400.1919 Communicable disease; immunization; mental and physical health; physician attestation; tuberculosis.

(1) An applicant shall obtain a written statement, signed by a licensed physician or his or her designee within 1 year before issuance of the initial license, that attests to the applicant's mental and physical health. The attestation must be renewed at the time of subsequent license renewals.

The licensee, Ms. Yoder, did not have a medical clearance completed prior to the renewal.

R 400.1919 Communicable disease; immunization; mental and physical health; physician attestation; tuberculosis.

(2) A licensee shall obtain from a child care staff member and a child care assistant a written statement, signed by a licensed physician or his or her designee within 1 year prior to caring for children, that attests to the child care staff member's or child care assistant's mental and physical health. The attestation must be renewed at the time of subsequent renewals of the child care home's license.

The licensee did not ensure child care staff member Ms. May had a medical clearance completed prior to the renewal.

A corrective action plan was requested and approved on 03/23/2023. It is expected that the corrective action plan be implemented within the specified time frames as outlined in the approved plan. A follow-up evaluation may be made to verify compliance. Should the corrections not be implemented in the specified time, it may be necessary to reevaluate the status of your license.

IV. RECOMMENDATION

I recommend issuance of a regular child care license to this center.
