

### III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

Staff records include background checks, medical clearance information, and training information. Children's records include child information cards and child in care statements/receipts.

The facility is in compliance with all applicable rules and statutes.

During the inspection, I observed children resting and receiving nurturing care. The social skills and pre-school preparation provided in this home are a part of every day interactions benefiting children.
