

Approved child use space: : Ms. Ramsey lives in a two-story home with a basement. The basement is used for child care and has a family room, play room, nap room, and game room. There is a bathroom located between the play room and game room. The main floor and the second level of her home are not approved for child care.

Exiting information (including second floor and basement): In the basement, there is a door located in the family room that provides a direct exit to the outside at ground level. In addition, there is a staircase leading to the main level which has exits available through the garage or out the front door.

Ms. Ramsey has a hot tub located on the back porch. The hot tub has a hard cover which remains locked when children are in care.
- Swimming pool? No Yes If yes, describe pool and barriers.
Ms. Ramsey has an above ground pool. It is 48 inches in height, therefore, inaccessible to children in care. The children in care that are 6 years or older are able to swim in the pool with parental permission.
- Other water hazards? No Yes If yes, describe.
- Fireplace or wood burning stove? No Yes If yes, describe.
Ms. Ramsey has a fireplace on the main level of the home.
- Fireplace/wood burner in use during child care hours? No Yes If yes, describe barriers to protect children from burns.

III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

This renewal inspection involved a review of all applicable child care home administrative rules and statutes. Verification of compliance included direct observations of the physical environment and the program, discussions with staff, and a review of the home's records, including staff records and children's records. Staff records include background checks, medical clearance information, and training information. Children's records include child information cards and child in care statements/receipts.


When I arrived for the inspection Ms. Ramsey was providing care to nine children; seven unrelated and two related. Ms. Ramsey's daughter was present and providing care for the two related children. Ms. Ramsey understands when her daughter is present she must be supervised at all times. I discussed with Ms. Ramsey the necessity of having her daughter fingerprinted through child care licensing and determined eligible if she is going to be a recurrent presence in her home and providing care to related children.

Ms. Ramsey is extremely organized and provides an environment conducive to learning. She has a sufficient amount of developmentally appropriate equipment available for the children to use. She is warm, nurturing, and communicates with the children in a positive manner.

The facility is in compliance with all applicable rules and statutes.

IV. RECOMMENDATION

I recommend issuance of a regular license to this child care group home (capacity 7-14).
