Dear Ms. Alassane:

This letter is a follow-up to the Department's findings regarding the interim inspection conducted at your home on 06/28/2022. The purpose of this inspection was to determine compliance with applicable licensing statutes and administrative rules for Family and Group Child Care Homes.

The violations that were found are:

R 400.1902 Applicant; licensee; requirements.

- (1) An applicant shall meet all of the following provisions:
- (e) Have documentation of completed training in both of the following:
 - (i) Recognition and reporting of child abuse and neglect.
 - (ii) Prevention and control of infectious disease, including immunizations.

Ms. Alassane did not have proof of completing recognition and reporting of child abuse and neglect or prevention and control of infectious disease. Ms. Alassane was sent the course descriptions for the required trainings in MiRegistry.

R 400.1905 Training.

- (3) A licensee shall ensure that child care staff members and child care assistants, prior to caring for children, have training that includes information on all of the following:

(b) Recognition of and the reporting of child abuse and neglect.

Ms. Alassane had one child care staff member that did not have proof of completing recognition of and the reporting of child abuse and neglect.

R 400.1905 Training.

(3) A licensee shall ensure that child care staff members and child care assistants, prior to caring for children, have training that includes information on all of the following:

(c) Prevention of shaken baby syndrome, abusive head trauma, and child maltreatment.

Ms. Alassane had one child care staff member that did not have proof of completing prevention of shaken baby syndrome, abusive head trauma, and child maltreatment.

R 400.1905 Training

(9) When the department of licensing and regulatory affairs or the department of education publishes a notice that a new health and safety update document or a new health and safety update training activity has been published on MiRegistry, the licensee shall ensure that all personnel read and acknowledge the document or complete the activity within 6 months of the notice.

Ms. Alassane did not have proof of completing the required 2021 health and safety refresher course.

I reviewed the following rules with Ms. Alassane:

R400.1907: Child's records.

R400.1920: Outdoor play area and equipment.

R400.1923: Diapering and toilet learning.

R400.1943: Exit requirements for each floor level used by children.

Due to the violations, you must send us a corrective action plan by 7/20/2022. You can use our [corrective action plan](#) form or create your own.

If you need help writing the corrective action plan, please contact me. If you do not send a corrective action plan, you may face disciplinary action. The corrective action plan must include the following:

- How compliance with each rule will be achieved.

- Who is directly responsible for implementing the corrective action for each violation.
- Specific time frames for each violation as to when the correction will be completed or implemented.
- How continuing compliance will be maintained once compliance is achieved.
- The signature of the responsible party and a date.

Upon receipt of an acceptable corrective action plan, there will be no change to your license status.


