Findings of the Inspection

The purpose of the Interim inspection was to determine compliance with applicable licensing statutes and administrative rules for child care Group Home.

During the Interim inspection, licensing consultant Karen Woodman found 2 violations. The violations are listed and explained below. Due to the violations, the licensee/licensee designee must send the bureau a [corrective action plan](#) by 6/25/2024. The corrective action plan may be submitted in the [Child Care Hub Information Record Portal \(CCHIRP\)](#). The corrective action plan must include the following:

- How compliance with each rule will be achieved.
- Who is directly responsible for implementing the corrective action for each violation.
- Specific time frames for each violation as to when the correction will be completed or implemented.
- How continuing compliance will be maintained once compliance is achieved.
- The signature of the responsible party and a date.

Due to the infant safe sleep violation(s), all of the facility's child care staff members must take training on infant safe sleep. This must be included in the facility's corrective action plan and completed by 6/18/2024. In addition, a follow up inspection may be made to check compliance with the infant safe sleep rules.

During the onsite inspection I observed free choice time and outside time. Interactions between child care staff members and children were positive and developmentally appropriate. There was an adequate amount of age-appropriate play and learning materials. Ms. Alassane chooses activities based on the ages and developmental levels of the children in care. Daily activities include story time, circle time, movement, alphabet, colors, and outside time.
