

Approved child use space: The basement has two play rooms and a kitchen approved for child care use. On the main level of the home the living room is approved for child care use.

Exiting information (including second floor and basement): There are two exits on the main level of the home; a front door and a sliding glass door which leads to an elevated porch that has stairs to ground level. The basement has a door which leads to the backyard and the stairs which lead to the main level.

Staff records include background checks, medical clearance information, and training information. Children's records include child information cards and child in care statements/receipts.

The facility is in compliance with all applicable rules and statutes.

R 400.1932: Home maintenance and safety

R 400.1943: Exit requirements for each floor level used by children.
