Exiting information (including second floor and basement): On the main level there is a front door which exits to grade and a sliding door on the back side of the home which exits to an elevated porch with stairs leading to ground level. The 4 lower level of the home has a clearly labeled exit which is a large picture window located in the playroom. The window is less than 44 inches from the floor and meets the qualifications of a window exit
