III. DESCRIPTION OF FINDINGS & CONCLUSIONS

This renewal inspection involved a review of all applicable child care home administrative rules and statutes. Verification of compliance included direct observations of the physical environment and the program, discussions with staff, and a review of the home's records, including staff records and children's records. Staff records include background checks, medical clearance information, and training information. Children's records include child information cards and child in care statements/receipts.

During the inspection, there were six children present with Ms. Greenacre and two child care staff members. While onsite, I observed free play, nap time, lunch, and educational programming. All child care staff members were nurturing toward the children. I observed them assisting children with tasks and positively reinforcing behavior to ensure safety. The child care has a vast amount of developmentally age-appropriate toys and equipment accessible to the children. The outdoor play area is entirely fenced in, and it is located in the front of the home. It features an airplane climber, play houses, slides, and various outdoor equipment.

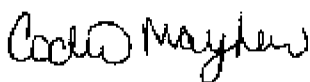
The facility is in compliance with all applicable rules and statutes.
